- a. Kurt Ronnfeldt – Track team mentioned wanting new hurdles w/ screen printing on them, flight carts, starting blocks, discus cage.
 - a.i. Would need hurdles by March, no safety issue with current hurdles.
 - a.ii. Cost would be \$14,000 - \$15,000
 - a.iii. Tabled this item for now
 - b. Kurt Ronnfeldt – Wrestling
 - b.i. Need new competition mat; cost is \$12,282. (42x42 mat)
 - b.i.1. Les Baumbach motioned to approve purchase, Jeremy Withrow seconded. Jenn Bollers motioned to discuss. Where does the school stand with money, will they contribute funds as well? Wrestling Club representatives present, let’s hear from them as well. Currently have 2 high school mats, only 1 need replaced at this time.
 - b.i.2. Les Baumbach motioned to mend to change the contribution to ½ the cost from the Booster Club and ½ the cost from the school. Discussion to be \$6,000 from Booster Club. Jeremy Withrow seconded the motion. All in favor – ayes – motion passed.
8. **Miscellaneous** - -
- a. Reminder that the State funds \$0 to school athletics, we need booster members, we need business donations, we need a village, we need people that want to make a difference to GET INVOLVED. You don’t need to have a child in high school to participate, be a part of the future now.
