2. **State of CCA Athletics Report**, Kurt Ronnfeldt – Athletic Director
  - a. Boys Track – 55 boys. Hosted last week and had some good numbers. Regional meet May 10 is Co-ed.
  - b. Girls Track – 37. Haven't had a great chance to get running in
  - c. Boys Soccer – 58 boys and currently 0-2 facing good competition
  - d. Girls Soccer – 39 girls and currently 0-2; young team and continuing to improve weekly
  - e. Girls golf (6 out) and Boys golf (16 out) due to weather they have barely had 2 practices outside and already have their first competition.
  - f. Baseball – indoor batting cages look great!
  - g. Cheerleading tryouts – FB will have 17 cheerleaders – great improvement in 1 year
  - h. Junior High track – over 150 boys and girls – great numbers out!

    - v. Heidi may have some things discounted in apparel booth, look for a few discounted items!!
